



Interac e-Transfer Payments

For 2023

An Interac e-Transfer is a fast, secure and convenient way to send money to anyone in Canada from within the security of your online banking service. It uses email for fast notification to the recipient that a transfer has been sent.

At the moment the Interac e-Transfer is available for transfers between Canadian financial institutions. See the FAQ link below which will have a list of the participating institutions.

For now, Interac e-Transfers cannot be post-dated so only full camp fee payments can be accepted at this time using this payment method.

Basic Process

- Login to your online or mobile banking at a participating financial institution
- Choose Interac e-Transfer within the Transfer/Payment menu options
- Select a recipient by entering an email address
 - Enter the name as "Skyline Hikers" and use the Registrar's email address of registrar@skylinehikers.ca
 - NOTE that the Skyline Hikers do not support the text messaging option for Interac. Only email can be used.
- Fill in the Interac e-Transfer information (dollar amount, account from which to withdraw the funds, a security question that only the recipient will know the answer to and optional personal message)
 - The security question should be "What's the secret Skyline Hikers code?" or words to that effect.
 - The answer to the security question must be Campbell2023Icefield and *do not put this answer in your optional personal message or share this password with other people*. Note that this answer is case sensitive so please type this in exactly as shown.
- Follow the instructions to confirm the information and complete the transfer.
- Your account may be charged a transfer fee (approximately \$1.00 to \$1.50) depending on your banking plan but only when the transfer is received by Skyline Hikers.
