Policy on Minor Participation

1. The minimum age for participation of a minor child is 8 (eight) years of age.
2. In general, the minor child must be directly supervised by the parent or legal guardian at all times. However, subject to the consent of the parent or legal guardian and subject to the prior approval of the Chief Leader a minor over the age of 12 (twelve) may participate in a hike without the direct supervision of the parent or legal guardian.
3. The Chief Leader has the sole discretion to refuse participation of a minor, even with direct supervision of a parent or legal guardian, in any activity, based on safety considerations for the minor child and/or other participants.
4. The parent or legal guardian shall promptly advise the Camp Medic during camp, of any changes to the medical condition of the minor child as disclosed on the Registration Form which might reasonably affect the safety and enjoyment of the minor child participating in any activities.
